

## How to subscribe the mailinglist

[sts\_l] is an open mailing list of researchers in the studies of Science, Technology, and Society in Switzerland (<http://www.sts-ch.org>).

### Introduction

The STS-L provides an open forum for the exchange of information and for discussions of issues related to Science and Technology Studies with a special focus on Switzerland. The STS mailing list may be regarded as one effort to encourage and to foster discussion and collaboration of people interested in STS. In a general view, the aim of the mailing list is to help building a web of scientists interested in STS in Switzerland.

The three main purposes of the STS mailing list are:

1. Exchange of information and announcements;
2. Discussions of STS issues, especially in a Swiss context;
3. Establishing connections between different STS research projects.

The STS list welcomes submissions concerning news, events, research projects, abstracts, book reviews, calls for papers, conference information and discussions about issues related to Science and Technology Studies.

### List policy

1. The STS\_L mailing list is open to all people interested in STS issues.
2. Postings to the mailing list are regarded as "public" within the circle of all participants.
3. Languages Messages to STS\_L should be written in English, French or German.
4. Moderation The STS-list is self-organised and **\*not\*** moderated.
5. Every poster is responsible for the content of her/his own postings.
6. Restrictions

Although it is technically possible to send messages up to 5 MB to the STS\_L-list, text-only messages are preferred (i.e. no binary files, no attachments, no HTML, etc.). To announce more complex information, participants are welcome to indicate a link to a related webpage (<http://...>).

Commercial announcements are not permitted, with the exception of job announcements, if posted by list participants.

7. Technical maintenance is provided by the so-called "editor", who reserves the right for intervention in case of massive violation of the list policy. The list-owner can be reached at [<sts\\_l-editor@soziologie.lists.uzh.ch>](mailto:sts_l-editor@soziologie.lists.uzh.ch).
